

Quick Facts on Special Exception Requests for a Short-Term Rental under the May 2019 STR Ordinance¹

- 26 Cases that the ZBA (Zoning Board of Adjustment) ruled on in three meetings held in June and July 2019
- 25 Applications approved for a special exception (96%)
- 17 Properties are owner-occupied (65%)
- 10 Approved applications managed by Bama B&B (38%)
- 11 Approved applications in District 3, the highest number of any district (42%)
